
O' LEVEL RESULTS JUNE 2023: CLASS 9

44 Class 9 students in CGSD appeared for 100 O' Levels, for between 2 and 3 subjects each. They did very well to appear with such limited in-person preparation. They opened their accounts for collecting $A \not \approx$ and A grades, achieving 49% for $A \not \approx /A$ grades and an $A \not \approx /A$ grades we had 82% ratio and overall 95% pass.

O' LEVEL RESULTS JUNE 2022/2023: CLASS 10

55 CGSD students appeared for 421 O' Levels subjects in June 2022 and June 2023. Combined results had an overall pass rate of 99% and an A ★, A and B ratio of 78%. 23 out of 55, over 42% of candidates attained 5A's or more in O' levels.
