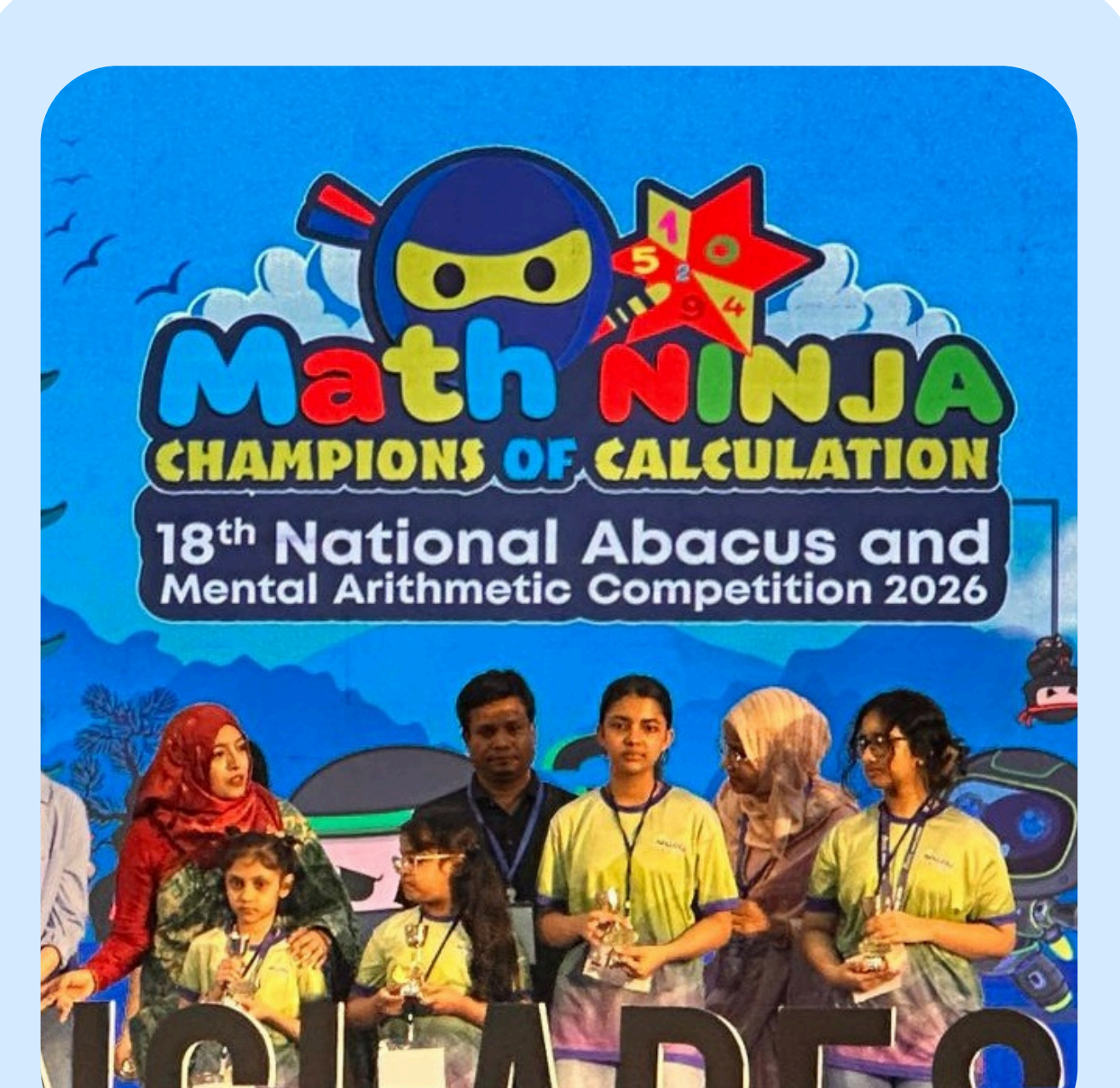
Elementary Park Visit
